



Nimbus acquires RCP Ranstadt

Nimbus has acquired all the shares of Budelpack Ranstadt.

Ranstadt is a specialised Personal and Home care site, located in the heart of the German packaging industry (Hessen). The site specialises in making and filling liquid and powder products in sachets / pouches and thermoformed packages and produces wipes. The site, that joined the Budelpack group in 2001, had been a part of Klöckner Pentapack since 1974.

Ranstadt is a centre of excellence for sachet and blister production. This encompasses the packaging and manufacturing of liquid cosmetics and wipes in shaped or rectangular sachets. Single-wet-wipes are Ranstadt's core business. The Ranstadt plant also produces effervescent products and tablets, with the main focus being on unit dose and sampling concepts. The plant has a highly qualified staff backed by state-of-the-art equipment and is capable of offering customers full-service programs.

The company name will be RCP Ranstadt and the company will reestablish itself again in the food market where it was active for many years.
